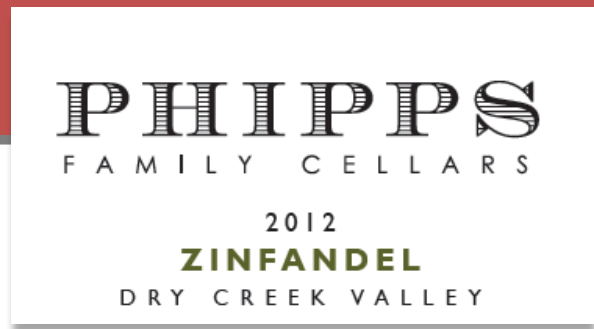

## Sip for Thought...



For this month's edition of the Dockett, I'd like to highlight Phipps Family Cellars 2012 Dry Creek Valley/Sonoma Co. Ranches Zinfandel. I was beyond fortunate enough to meet Mr. Andy Phipps, proprietor of Phipps Family Cellars, this last month, and to say he's passionate about his craft would be the understatement of the year.

### ABOUT PHIPPS FAMILY CELLARS

Phipps Family Cellars (PFC) is a boutique winery located in the Napa Valley. They produce small-to-medium-sized lots of ultra-premium wines from the finest vineyards in the Napa & Sonoma Valleys. PFC was founded in 2004 by Jennifer and Andy Phipps with the simple belief that through high-quality and consistency in our wines, we will develop a cult following among those individuals who have tried our wines, year after year. And now for the wine... As Andy bluntly put it, "This is a Cab-Lover's Zinfandel!"

### WINEMAKER NOTES

The 2012 harvest was excellent. Growing conditions throughout the year were ideal for producing a bumper crop of mature grapes with balanced flavors. In the spring, our Zin vines set a large crop. During the summer, we had an abundance of California coastal "sweater" weather, fog in the morning, and warm sunshine in the afternoon, often sending temperatures into the mid-90s and then quickly cooling off after sunset. These daily temperature swings help make Sonoma County and the Dry Creek & Alexander Valleys great places to grow wine grapes. This daily cyclical temperature shift, occasionally hitting 50 degrees at night, continued into October, and ripened fruit evenly and slowly, allowing us to bring in harvest at a steady measured pace.

The 2012 Sonoma County Ranches (SCR) Zinfandel is a powerful wine that can be described as "Classic Zinfandel" with a core of blackberry, white pepper, and dark chocolate. The 2012 SCR Zinfandel is further characterized by Spanish cherries, dark raspberry, and boysenberry fruit that mingle with vanilla, anise, cinnamon, toasty oak, and allspice.

With an extremely limited production of 275 cases, the Oconomowoc Lake Club is very fortunate to currently offer a Zinfandel of this caliber! In addition to the Zinfandel, I'm also able to offer a limited selection of PFC 2009 Cabernet Sauvignon. Touted by the winemaker Andy as "An absolute show-stopper," this Cabernet is relatively amazing! Definitely drinkable now, but is beyond cellar-worthy through 2020.
