FEATURED RECIPE OF THE MONTH



Pineapple Cream Cake

Ingredients

Crust & Topping Cake

1 ½ cup graham cracker crumbs 10 oz marshmallows 2 T sugar 3/4 c milk

3 ½ oz butter 16 oz cream cheese

2 c heavy cream, slightly sweetened 1 medium can crushed pineapple,

drained

In a 9" spring form pan, make graham cracker crust by mixing all Crust & Topping ingredients. Be sure to save ½ cup for topping. Bake crust at 350° for approximately 8-10 minutes or until golden. In a large mixing bowl, melt marshmallows in milk. Let cool. Whip cream cheese and fold into marshmallow mixture. Whip heavy cream slightly sweeten, and fold into marshmallow mixture. Fold pineapple into the mixture. Finally, pour mixture over cooled graham cracker crust and cover with remaining topping crumbs. Chill a minimum of 4 hours, best to chill over night.






