



Alexander Valley Cabernet has been blowing my mind lately! Overwhelming, lush, decadence in a glass. The unpredictability of, what was, 2014's vintage provides even greater want for these wines. Early budbreak and flowering and a mid-August cool spell, in Sonoma, led to great reward via deep color and dense, luscious texture. The grapes were harvested in the morning and fully crushed and destemmed before fermentation in 100% stainless steel. This Cabernet Sauvignon was then aged in varying-toasted French Oak barrels for 30 months.

WINEMAKER NOTES:

Deep purple in color, the Outlot Cabernet Sauvignon has a rich nose filled with black currant, cherry, fennel, cola, and licorice. Full bodied with a plush tannin entry, the palate has abundant red cherry fruit, mission fig, pepper rose and savory spice that carries through to a medium-firm finish.




