These touted offerings, all of 2013 vintage, include Caymus Vineyards, Stags' Leap Winery, and last, but certainly not least, Cakebread Cellars. Out of the Napa Valley origin, these three Cabernet's showcase the astute elegance their respective wineries strive to provide.

Each year, the whims of Mother Nature provide unique conditions and within Napa Valley, 2013 brought a warm spring and consistently mild summer, which fostered a steady, even ripening for these respective varietals. In summation, it was an excellent year for all of California and especially Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon grapes! Listed below, are the winemaker's notes and critical acclaim for these three offerings. Worth every penny, I strongly urge anyone and everyone that enjoys this specific varietal to drink immediately, or cellar, for those of us who have the patience to do so!

Winemaker's Notes

Critical Acclaim

2013 Caymus Vineyards Cabernet Sauvignon

The 2013 growing season was another great one in Napa Valley. Deep, red and opulent in color, this wine opens with the vibrant scent of dark cherry and blackberry, subtly layered with warm notes of vanilla. The palate is explosive with flourishes of cocoa and sweet tobacco that provide nuance and continually shifting points of interest. This wine is lush yet structured, with a texture that grabs attention, expands and unfolds. Fruit, oak and acidity are held in balance throughout the long, drawn-out finish.

Wine Spectator - "Rich, smooth and creamy, with vanilla, mocha, dark berry and licorice notes, offering a compelling mix of subtly sweet flavors set in a graceful, supple texture. Drink now through 2025."

2013 Stag's Leap Winery Cabernet Sauvignon

The 2013 Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon opens with generous dark cherry, juicy plum, currant and cassis, while accents of black pepper and chocolate give it a classic feel. Seamlessly integrated oak and refined tannins provide wonderful texture while the bright, fresh fruit flavors balance the wine's impressive concentration.

The Wine Advocate - "The 2013 Cabernet Sauvignon from was aged 20 months in French oak, of which 37% was new. This is a structured, tannic, rather austere style of wine that mimics a fine Bordeaux. It is deep ruby/purple and offers notes of graphite, black and red currants, licorice and tobacco leaf. It is medium-bodied, structured, and best cellared for several years and drunk over the following 15 years.

2013 Cakebread Cellars Cabernet Sauvignon

Luxurious dark cherry, boysenberry, blackcurrant and black fig aromas, with scents of oak toast and dark chocolate, introduce layers of rich, deeply concentrated, yet elegant flavors of blackberry, boysenberry, fig, currant and fresh cherry. The wine's vibrant acidity, supple, seamlessly integrated tannins and impeccable balance contribute to a round, plush mouthfeel, leading to a long, savory finish marrying rich boysenberry fruit, French oak spice and a hint of dark chocolate. Remarkably delicious young, this classic Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon will develop even greater allure with another 7-10 years' bottle age.

James Suckling - "An attractive wine with blueberry, mineral and dark chocolate aromas and flavors. Medium to full body, silky tannins and a delicious finish."

The Wine Advocate - Aged primarily in French oak, the wine is youthful and young, with the coiled, restrained character of many 2013s, but the concentration is impressive and the purity is there. There is a reasonably good value as well. Give it another 6-12 months bottle age, and drink it over the following 12-15 years.



The Zieche Family




